All models in the Concorde Music range feature the same body type and generator system, allowing for easy stylus upgrades in the future. Inside, silver-plated oxygen free copper is chosen for the quadcoil system together with four Ortofon split pole pins, delivering a clear, powerful 6mV output of dynamic, lifelike sound with an exceptional clarity and fidelity to your connected phono stage.



Each model in the Concorde Music range is identified by its coloured stylus, reflecting its position in the range, and the type of sound you can expect...

Concorde Music Red features a high-quality elliptical diamond stylus profile for an impressive entry-level performance.

With the **Concorde Music Blue** you can expect a more refined performance thanks to its nude elliptical diamond, taking you one step closer to the musical performance.

Boasting a nude fine line diamond stylus profile, the **Concorde Music Bronze** unlocks a whole new level of precision and detail, which fits into a deep and engaging musical landscape.

For a true-to-life musical performance, the **Concorde Music Black** presents everything exactly as the artist intended thanks to a truly high-end nude Shibata stylus profile.

Concorde Music LVB 250 is the flagship of the series, thanks to its mounting of a nude Shibata diamond on a high-quality boron cantilever. The result is a sound performance like a more expensive moving coil design. This is true high-end excellence.

Installation of the Concorde range is effortless. Simply insert it into an SME-style tonearm headshell socket and lock it into place. There are no screws or fiddly wires, so all that is required is a simple tonearm balance to achieve the desired tracking force.
